SATURDAY, MAY 15TH: DRESS REHEARSAL

Enter the main entrance of Shawnee Mission West on 85th Street and above the doors, it will say "Auditorium". That is the correct entrance for the weekend!

ARRIVAL/CHECK-IN PROCESS

This is a mandatory dress rehearsal for dancers to attend the spring recital on Sunday. Each routine will have a designated check-in time. Dancers and parents will not be able to enter the building early. Dancers will need to arrive completely ready in their first costume, and if they are in multiple dances please be sure to have all other costumes in clearly labeled garment bags.

Enter those doors and JPDC staff will direct you to the correct space for student check-in. Only one parent per dancer will be able to enter the building for the dress rehearsal.

When you arrive at the entrance, JPDC staff will direct you to check in. Dancers will be checked in and taken backstage. Parents will stay out in the lobby and designated waiting areas while the dancers are practicing on stage. **Parents will not be allowed in the auditorium to watch dress rehearsal.** If your dancer is in multiple dances, they will exit the auditorium and **parents will be responsible for changing them into their next costume.** Dancer will be checked in for their next routine after they are changed.

BALLET REHEARSAL

Please note that there is an update: Dancers will check in at 1:30 and have rehearsal for all ballet dancers from 2:00-4:00pm. **THIS IS NOT A DRESS REHEARSAL.** Dancers will need to wear their class leo or a black leo, tights and ballet flats.

SAFETY

We request for the safety of our dancers, parents, families and staff to please not attend this event if you're feeling sick, have a fever of 100.4 or higher, or additional symptoms. All audience members and dancers ages 6 and older will be required to wear a mask or face shield per Shawnee Mission School Guidelines.

LEAVING/CHECKING OUT PROCESS

After your dancer's dress rehearsal ends, they will leave the auditorium and JPDC staff will bring them back to parents to check them out to parents. If your dancer is in another routine, you will be able to help them change for the next costume. Please be patient during this process as it's for the safety of our dancers. JPDC Staff will be there to assist you in any way if you have questions during this process!

SUNDAY, MAY 16TH: SPRING RECITAL

ARRIVAL/CHECK-IN PROCESS

All dancers will need to check in 20 minutes before their show time. Only one adult may enter the building per dancer to get them checked in. All other adults and attendees will wait outside, the audience will be able to enter the building and into the auditorium 10 minutes before show time. Dancers or families will not be able to enter the building early. Dancers will need to arrive completely ready in their first costume, and if they are in multiple dances please be sure to have all other costumes in clearly labeled garment bags. After entering the building, JPDC Staff will direct you to check in.

Once it's time for everyone to enter the building, all attendees ages 4 and older will show their wristband to staff to enter the auditorium, and all families will be asked to social distance in the theatre – keeping two seats in between each group of attendees. **There will be absolutely no photography or videotaping during the show.** If you would like to get an HD video of the performances, make sure you visit the website and turn in the Spring Recital Media Form to the office:

If your dancer is in multiple dances, **parents will be responsible for changing them into their next costume.**

TICKETS/WRISTBANDS: Tickets are currently available for purchase through your Studio Director account. Tickets will be available for purchase at the event. Please note that wrist bands will be \$20 for one show, \$30 for two shows and \$40 for all shows – if you're planning to pay with a credit card there is a convenience fee. Ticket prices are lower if you pay through your account before the day of the event. Any wristbands not picked up by Friday, May 14th will be available for pick up at the ticket table on recital day.

SAFETY

We request for the safety of our dancers, parents, families and staff to please not attend this event if you're feeling sick, have a fever of 100.4 or higher, or additional symptoms. All audience members and dancers ages 6 and older will be required to wear a mask or face shield per Shawnee Mission School Guidelines.

FINALE: LEAVING/CHECKING OUT PROCESS

The last number is our finale where all the dancers in the show will come on stage and do a final dance together. Dancers will remain on stage as the JPDC Directors will recognize our seniors as we finish the show. After the show ends, parents will be dismissed row by and row. We ask that one parent comes to get their child from the check in/check out table and the rest of the adults go immediately outside the building - no loitering in the lobby. If your dancer is in the following shows, you may stay in your seats until the next show begins. Please be patient while we are checking out all dancers, this is for the safety of our dancers.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR SHAWNEE MISSION WEST

Please read and review the policies and procedures for our JPDC dancers and families! These are venue guidelines and will be strictly enforced for the safety of our dancers and families. All attendees and dancers ages 6 and older will be REQUIRED to wear a mask or face shield the entire time, including performances. All seats are first come first serve, attendees will not be allowed in the auditorium until JPDC staff opens the doors as we sanitize and get ready for the next shows. Please be patient as we clean and ensure the safety of all our families.
